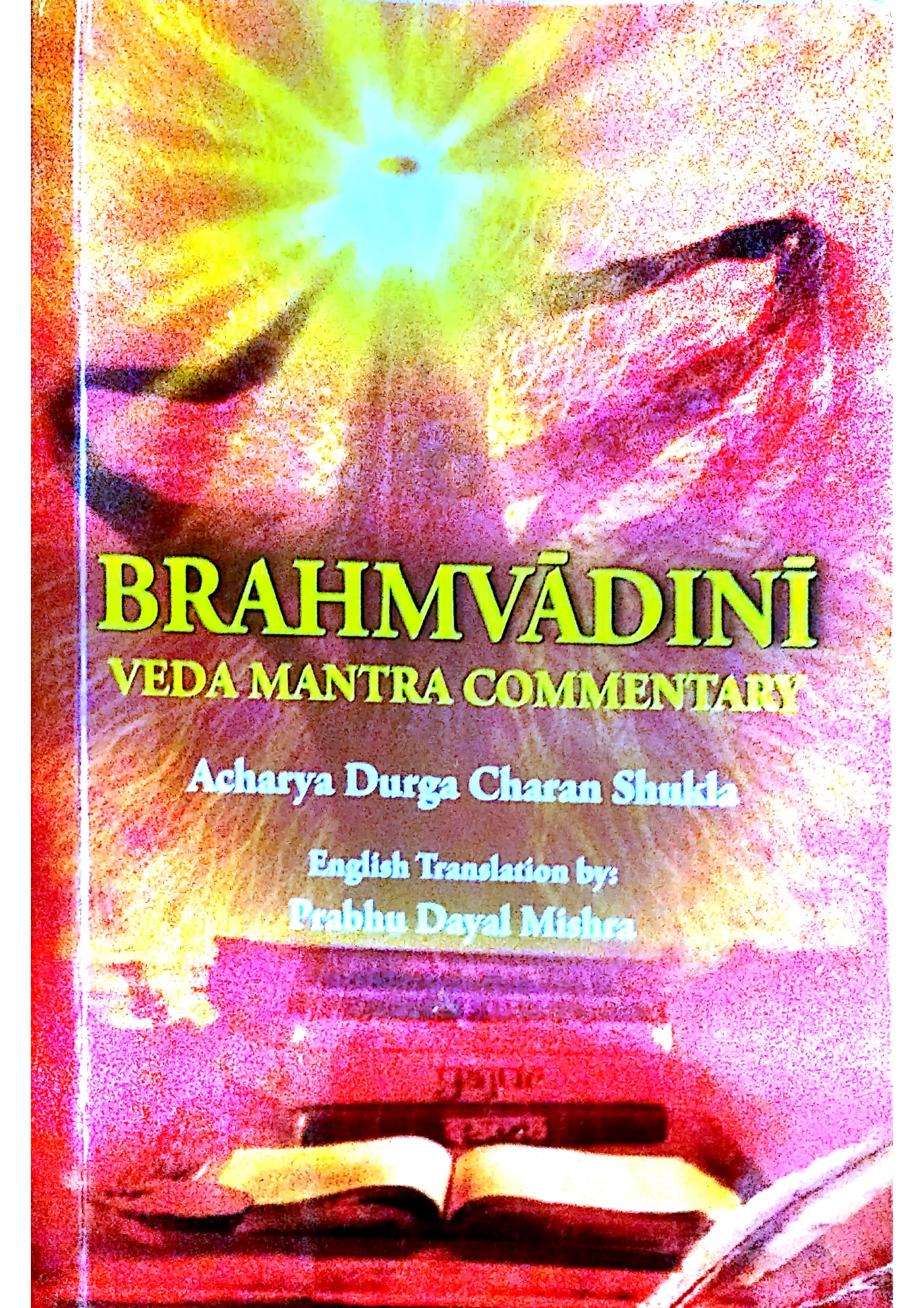

Born on 6th November 1930 in village Virguan, District Jalaun, Uttar Pradesh, Acharya Durgacharan Shukla served in School Education Department of Government of Madhya Pradesh and retired in 1990. Under divine blessings of late Pitambrapeeth Swamiji of Datia and an insightful deep Vedic vision of the world, his few scholarly pursuits consist of following works - 1. Pandit Prabhu Dayal Mishra, an eminent writer and thinker on Yoga, Gita, Upanishads and Vedas, born in 1946 in Tikamgarh Madhya Pradesh, post graduated in English Literature from the University of Sagar in 1968. Having joined administrative services of the Government of Madhya Pradesh through competitive examination in 1971, he also carried forward his scholarly pursuits undergoing deep spiritual courses of inner awakening and knowledge under the

guidance and protection of great spiritual masters. Based on his initiation into Yoga, Shaktipat and Vedanta, he has delivered lectures on Vedas, Yoga and Vedant philosophy during his travels to the erstwhile USSR (1989), USA (2004, 2010, 2014 and 2017), UAE (2014) and Mauritius (2015). Presently Mr. Mishra is the President of Maharishi Agastya Vedic Sansthanam Bhopal and is actively associated with a few Universities and cultural academic Institutions as a consultant and guest speaker.
